Presentation 1 :

Palm Oil Supply and Market Outlook 2019 – with special reference to weather-supply-demand dynamics. By Mr. Ling Ah Hong

Mr. Ling graduated from the University of Malaya with a Bachelor of Agricultural Science (Honors).

He has more than 40 years of experience in research and management of plantation crops and companies. He was a former **Executive Director of IJM Plantations** and his other past positions include: Research Officer with FELDA, Senior Agronomist in Dunlop Estates (now part of IOI Corporation), Plantation Controller of Perlis Plantations (now part of Wilmar International), Chief Operating Officer for Hap Seng Plantations. Mr. Ling has authored and co-authored numerous publications on oil palm and cocoa in Malaysia. He is also a frequent speaker at international conferences and seminars organized by Bursa Malaysia, GAPKI, MPOC, MPOB and investment banks.

He is currently the **Director and Principal Consultant of Ganling Sdn Bhd**, a Malaysian-based company focusing on plantation research, consulting and investments.

Presentation 2 :

Challenges and Opportunities for Palm Oil in 2017 and Beyond – An Analyst’s Perspectives By Ms. Ivy Ng Lee Fang

Ivy Ng is currently the Head of Malaysia Research and Regional Head of Agribusiness in CIMB. She is a CFA charterholder and holds a BSc in Economics from the London School of Economics. She has been covering the palm oil sector since the mid-90s and expanded her coverage to include the regional palm oil companies since 2005. She took on the role of Malaysian equity strategist since 2016. She joined CIMB in 2005 and has been an investment analyst since 1994, with prior stints in Affin-UOB, Peregrine Research, Hwang-DBS Securities and GK Goh Research. Ivy was ranked number one by Asiamoney polls as the best Malaysian strategist for 2017, best Malaysian industrial analyst for four consecutive years from 2014 to 2017 and utilities analyst in 2007 and 2008. She was also voted Malaysia’s best power analyst in 2007 and best plantation analyst in 2008 by The Edge.

Presentation 3 :

World Economic Outlook for 2018 and Beyond By Mr. Lee Heng Guie

Mr. Lee has 30 years of professional experience as an economist, including almost 12 years in Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) and 18 years in financial services. Since 2002, he has been the Head of Economic Research at CIMB Investment Bank Berhad, where he supervised a team of economists covering global and regional economies. Currently, he is also a guest writer for Focus Malaysia.

Mr. Lee holds a BA (Hons) majoring in Economics from University of Malaya, Malaysia and a Master’s Degree in Development Economics from Williams College, USA. He served in the Economics Department of BNM from 1984 to 1996 as a Senior Economist, where he was responsible for research and policy formulation. He also co-authored discussion papers and BNM’s Annual Report articles.

Mr. Lee is the recipient of many awards including getting voted as “Best Economist” in The Edge Pools twice, ranked Top 3 four times from 2000 to 2008, and selected as “Best Economist – Local Currency Bond Market of Malaysia” by the Asset Magazine Hong Kong in 2007. Under his leadership, CIMB macroeconomic research was ranked Top 3 for nine consecutive years (2005-2013) in the Asiamoney Polls.
