## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PLAY**

### **1.0 DATE AND VENUE**

The tournament will be held on Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at Glenmarie Golf & Country Club (GGCC), Shah Alam, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

### **2.0 TEE OFF TIME**

Participants are requested to arrive at their respective tee-box before 7.50 a.m. Scorecards will be allocated to members of each flight during registration.

### **3.0 RULE OF PLAY**

All play shall be in accordance with the Local and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrew Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Club where the competition is being held.

### **4.0 MODE OF PLAY**

The tournament will be played on Stableford Format and System 36 will determine the handicap for the day or latest Home Club handicap, whichever is lower.

(Note: In the case of a tie, the Rule Committee will use the count back system which is based on the lower handicap of the day, followed by 2<sup>nd</sup> Nine score total to determine the absolute winner)

## 5.0 PRIZES

The following are the prizes allocated for this tournament:

### A. For Companies or Organisations.

i. **One Challenge Trophy will be presented:**

To one (1) Company or Organisation, represented by one (1) best score by a golfer, playing under the banner of the said company.

ii. **Two Medals will be presented:** 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up and 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up

To two (2) Companies or Organisations, represented by one (1) best score by a golfer, playing under the banner of the said company.

iii. All other Companies or Organisation, will receive one (1) participation medal.

### B. For Individuals.

i. **One Challenge Trophy will be presented:**

To the overall winner of the Game based on Gross Score.

ii. **One Challenge Trophy will be presented:**

To the player with the Best Net Score (Gross Score minus Handicap of the day).

iii. **Nine Medals will be presented:**

To top three (3) winners for Medal A (Handicap 0-15), B (Handicap 16-20) and C (Handicap 21-36), respectively.

\* Both Challenge Trophy winners will relinquish their positions in the Medals category.

### C. Novelty Prizes.

- b) The decision of the Organizing Committee on all matters concerning the tournaments shall be final.

## **7.0 ATTIRE**

Sports shirt with collar and sleeves. Shirt must be tucked into trousers/pants or shorts (not more than 6 inches above the knees). No metal spikes are allowed on the golf course.
